« A best-practice example of integrated risk management:

The glacial lake outburst flood from the Tête Rousse glacier, from the memory of the 1892 event to the 2010 crisis »

April, 20th 2011, in Grenoble

In 1892 a glacial outburst flood originating from the Tête Rousse glacier triggered a major disaster on the community of St Gervais (Haute-Savoie, France), causing 175 fatalities and huge damages. Over a century later, a 65.000 m³ water pocket is discovered under the same glacier. A possible similar catastrophe is avoided in 2010 thanks to a good cooperation of every stakeholders involved in the risk management cycle. This case-study represents a best-practice example of integrated risk management, which the PARN would like to share with the AdaptAlp partners.


